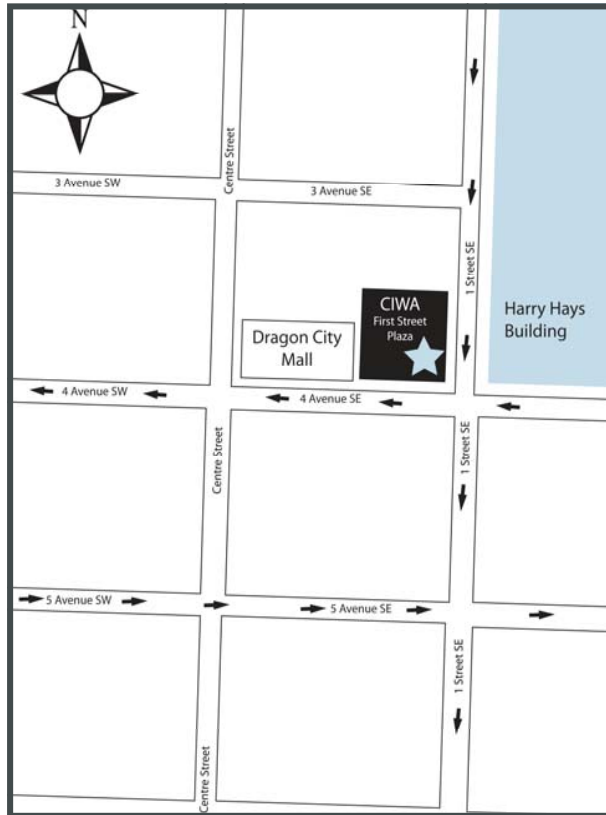

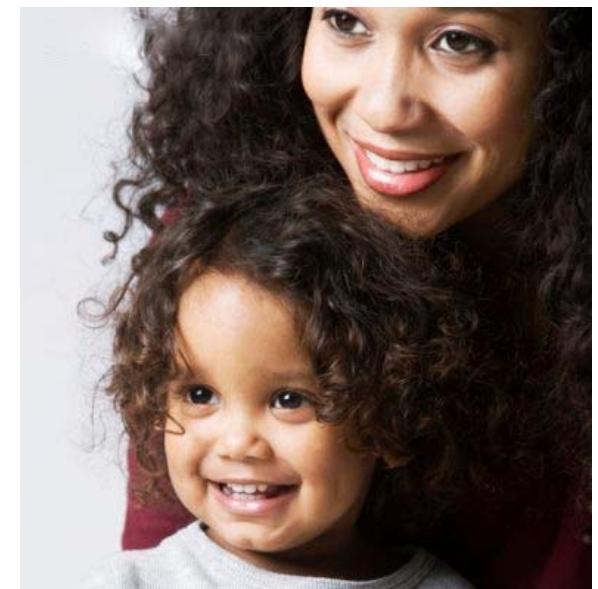

Childcare Training for Low Literacy Immigrant Women Project



Program Description

Childcare Training for Low Literacy Immigrant Women project is an 11 month full-time occupational language training program to achieve Level 1 Child Development Assistant certification.

There are four phases of training:

1. English language and essential skills training
2. Level 1 Childcare Orientation course (through Bow Valley College)
3. Employment skills training
4. 2 month mentored work experience in a daycare



Who can Apply

Immigrant women who:

- Have permanent resident, Canadian citizenship or refugee status
- Are ineligible for or have completed their LINC hours
- Have 0-7 years of education in native country
- Have a Canadian benchmark level 2, 2, 1, 1 or higher
- Would like to work as a daycare assistant in Canada
