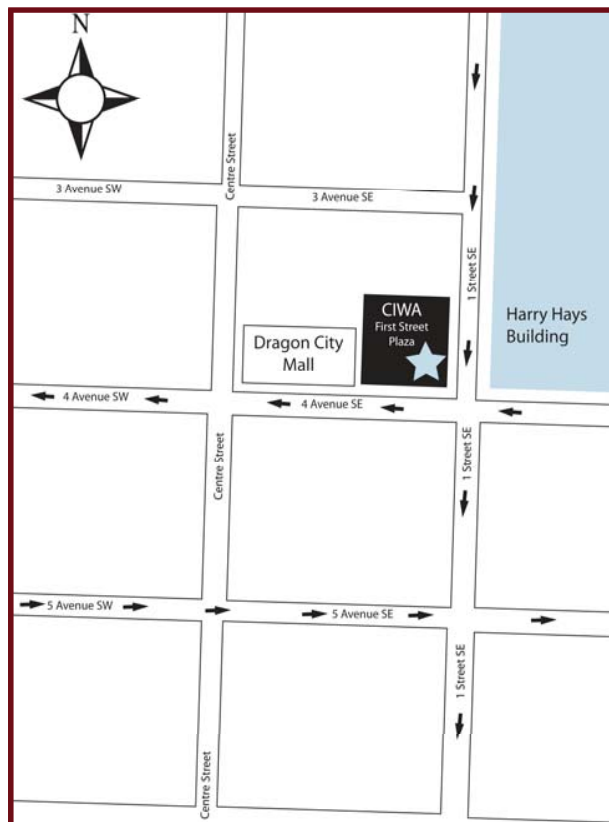


Vision: Women from diverse backgrounds are empowered to reach their goals and dreams as equal and contributing members of Canadian society.
