SUMMARY OF POSITION

Volunteers will assist junior high and high school students with homework assignments in one of the core subjects: Math, Science, Social Studies, and/or English. Time commitment is 2 hours on Friday afternoon for one school semester/term

- Expect to answer homework questions from students
- Be on time for programing
- Respect and collaborate well with students, other volunteers, and staff,
- Be culturally competent and respect program values
- Provide group session summary when requested
